INTRODUCTION

Creole Chronology is a compilation and arrangement of time highlighting the experiences, events, conditions, changes, frustrations, suppression, important quotations, and recognition, which all combine contributes to the evolution, perpetuation, and current existence of Louisiana's French Creole nation. And more than anything else the reader shall realize that the color of an individual's skin does not place that individual into a specific culture, nor does it removes him/her from specific culture. Culture has no color.
